CODE OF PRACTICE FOR HAULAGE CONTRACTORS

To be read and signed prior to returning. Please keep a copy for your files.

The contractor is responsible for ensuring all personnel are familiar with these Codes of Practice and abide by them.

- 1. All lorries shall be internally clean and swept out before loading. The outside shall be as clean as possible. Records of cleaning may be required from time to time.
- 2. Contractors shall not carry the following items in tandem with any product from Ripon Select Foods:

Noxious substances; Glass or other fragile items; Products which may taint, eg oils, chemicals, strong smelling products; sharp items; animal products/by-products; unpackaged items.

- 3. All contracting staff shall wear suitable overalls and hats on our premises and on our customers' premises.
- 4. If access is required by contracting staff into our warehouse or factory areas, all loose jewellery, including watches, shall be removed and hairnets shall also be worn.
- 5. Ear protection must be worn in designated areas.
- 6. Smoking is prohibited on our premises and our customers' premises, except in designated areas.
- Flat bed lorries are not considered to be a suitable means of transportation of foodstuffs and foodstuff packaging.
- 8. All contracting staff shall report to the warehouse office on arrival and before loading or unloading.
- 9. All vehicles, before leaving the site, shall weigh off and shall ensure all documentation is correct.
- 10. All pallets are returnable.
